



ROADGEAR CUSTOM CARGO LINER MATS SOLID RIB STYLE

Fitting & Care Instructions:

Your new Roadgear Cargo Mat has been custom moulded to fit and protect your vehicles cargo floor area whilst providing increased load stability. Please follow these instructions to ensure easy fitment and maximum life of the product is achieved: -

- 1. Firstly, clear the cargo area of any loose obstacles
- 2. Ensure the floor space is clean & dry by sweeping or washing
- 3. Remove the Cargo Mat from the packaging and unroll on a flat clean surface
- 4. Flip the mat over so the "Ribbed" side is orientated upwards
- 5. Establish which end will be pointing towards the front of the vehicle and roll the mat up again from this end
- 6. Place the rolled-up Cargo Mat at the tailgate end of the vehicle
- 7. Position the Cargo Mat in a way that allows it to roll out towards the front of the vehicle
- 8. Allow the Cargo Mat to unroll and adjust the position to locate for best fit.
- 9. Note: Your vehicle may be fitted with genuine or aftermarket accessories such as a Tub Liner or Roll Bar etc. that may require some trimming.
- 10. If required, take a marking pen and trace an outline where the material is to be removed. Carefully use sharp scissors or knife to cut and remove any excess or overhanging edges of the mat to create a true custom fit
- 11. Re-test the fit and make any necessary additional mark lines and cuts to ensure a snug fit
- 12. Repeat this process until the desired fit is achieved



- Remove Cargo Mat from packaging & unroll orientating the ribbed side up
- Establish which end will be towards the front of the vehicle and roll the mat up again
- Place at the tailgate end in a way to allow it to roll out towards the front
- Allow the Cargo Mat to unroll and adjust the position to locate for best fit



- If required, outline any areas to be removed due to accessories & carefully cut and remove any excess or overhanging edges
- Follow care and maintenance instructions

Regular and appropriate maintenance of your Boot Mat will: -

- Extend the life and maintain the appearance of your Cargo Mat by reducing the harsh effects of dirt and oils on the mat surface and backing.
- Also increase the efficiency of the functionality of your mat by maintaining a surface that will grip better
- Reduce the risk of rust and corrosion of the cargo area flooring by allowing the circulation of air & moisture


For best results, your Cargo Mat should receive scheduled cleaning. Cargo Mats are designed to protect your vehicles Cargo floor area whilst assisting to stabilise a load. Simply follow these instructions to keep your Cargo Mat looking great, remaining easy to maintain and functioning effectively.


Daily maintenance:

Whilst in the vehicle, sweep the mat down removing any grit or debris. Also clean the mat down after any oil, greese or petrochemical spills using a cloth or sponge with a mild detergent.

Weekly maintenance:

Take the cargo Mat out of the vehicle if possible and turn & shake to remove excess dirt and debris. Lay the Cargo Mat on a flat clean surface and wash down with warm water and a mild detergent. You can also use a pressure washer set on low while being careful not to place the nozzle too close that it may damage the mat. Hose or rinse off and hang to allow to drip dry for a few minutes. Before placing back in the vehicle, ensure the cargo area is cleaned down using a broom or vacuum cleaner.







CAUTION:

DO NOT USE steam, degreasers, caustic or harsh chemicals, solvents or petroleum-based products. Do not machine wash or mechanically scrub the mats.
